Camp Adventure 2020 Information

Hello Camp Parents!

With Camp Adventure 2020 right around the corner, we are compiling a Frequently Asked Questions and Answers page to help ease your mind on Summer Camp this summer! We are also providing all of the additional steps we as a Camp will be taking to ensure that we are keeping everybody as safe as possible.

Safety protocols that the Camp Adventure Staff will be taking this summer, along with following CDC guidelines:

As follows:

1. Every staff and child's temperature's taken with parent(s) present in the morning / also ask the parents to take their temperature at night.
 2. During sign in and sign out times parents and children will be socially distanced 6 feet apart.
 3. Sanitation immediately before the children are allowed in the door.
 4. Rotating kid schedules for the campers / staff. One way directions, OUT the office door and IN the gym door, etc.
 5. We will be keeping our campers in small groups at ALL TIMES. The small groups will be 10 children maximum.
 6. We will be wiping down equipment, tables, sport equipment, door handles, after every rotation. For example, if group 1 is in the game room from 9 am to 10 am, and then group 2 is scheduled to be in the game room from 10 am to 11 am, we will be sanitizing the game room after group 1 leaves and before group 2 enters.
 7. If Berks County / Pennsylvania goes back to the "Red" phase – we will be closing Camp Adventure indefinitely.
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Frequently Asked Questions:

What are the Camp Dates?

Camp will be running from June 29th to August 21st.

Is there a maximum capacity?

Yes – this year while following CDC guidelines the Board of Directors and BCMC Staff can only safely accommodate **75 kids** for Camp Adventure 2020.

What is the Camp Adventure Tuition Cost?

There will be a \$100 deposit collected to ensure your child's spot in the program. This \$100 will go towards your overall cost of \$1080 for the 8 week program.

How much is morning and extended care?

The same as year's past, \$30 for Morning Care weekly and \$30 for Extended Care weekly.

What are the ages to Camp Adventure?

Ages 6 to 13.

Will there be field trips?

This year, due to COVID-19, we will not be taking any field trips as we want to control as many variables as we can to ensure your child's safety. However, we will still be utilizing going to Main Bird Park as well as Rustic Park to fish and do outside activities.

Can I sign up for Individual weeks instead of all 8 ?

Will Junior Counselors attend camp this year?

Yes – they will be treated like staff and will have a role at camp this year. Ages are 14 and 15 years old.

Will masks be required?

Our Staff will be wearing masks for any inside / close quarter activities that we do with the children.

Will I get refunded if there is another outbreak and we need to cancel the remainder of Camp?

Yes – Pro Rated refunds will be provided.
